1.1 Citizen's comments

Rachel Hisler gave a Citizen's Comment. She told the Court she was initially concerned when she saw the posting for a meeting regarding possible new Certificates of Obligation, but that she was encouraged when she saw the projects listed were for roads and drainage.

Former Commissioner Bill Wallace also gave a Citizen's Comment in favor of the proposed Certificates of Obligation. He encouraged the Court to move forward quickly as costs were rising.

A.C. Lowe also gave a Citizen's Comment. He said he was glad the projects were infrastructure projects as opposed to projects for "a few special interests." He questioned the timing of a possible sale, since interest rates were expected to go down soon. He also made the observation that the list of projects looked nothing like the warranty.

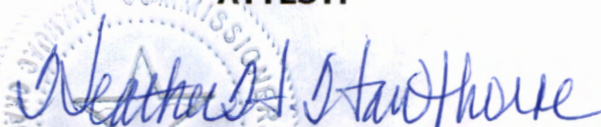

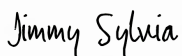
